



- STEM Conference:
  - Damian and Daniel Hugo (Head of Dept Science) recently attended the National STEM conference in Sydney.
  - The school is on track to be ready for the establishment of the GATE program in 2020 (The new STEM building will be finished in October 2019).
  - It is possible that STEM will include the Arts as well by the time implementation happens which means it will become STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths).
  - CSHS has set up a STEM committee to ensure we are ready for the GATE program which is chaired by Daniel Hugo.
