Business arising from previous minutes:

Damian and Dan Young to meet to look at questionable asbestosis around Carine SHS.

• Damian, Dan and Ryan met after the meeting to look at some areas around the school. A meeting is to be arranged when all parties are available to look at other areas of the school. Dan and Damian to arrange a meeting time. Dan presented the P&C with documentation about asbestos and requirements in handling it.

Correspondence in:

- Letter from parents for Tori Leaver and Zayla Walters.
 - Tori and Zayla have been selected into the state netball team and are requesting funding to support their trip. The P&C fundraising policy is for a whole school approach with a body of students involved and generally with school engagement. It was felt this was outside of the P&C fundraising policy and the P&C wouldn't contribute towards this request. Lisa Cocks to reply to requestors.
- All invoices or requests for payments MUST be approved by the committee at a general meeting. The only exceptions to this is the Canteen Wages and Payment for Suppliers to canteen. This reminder comes in light of a "scam" that's been building over the past week where someone fraudulently pretended to get an amount paid to a Brisbane bank account. As a result of this matter it has been reported to police.
 - This incident was identified before any payment was paid. Nathan received an email from what looked like Lisa's email account asking for an invoice to be paid.

Principals Report – Damian Shuttleworth

- Building Program
 - The building project is all going well. Due to be completed by October 2019 and ready for occupation in 2020.
 - The new build does include a cafeteria as a part of the Home Economics complex. This won't be open to the public but will be used for guests to the school and events.
 - New and refurbished science classrooms, Home Economics complex, and phys ed change rooms are included in the new build.
 - Other info: the site is big enough to accommodate the increase in student numbers, other updates to the school will include cover in the quadrangle and the removal of the shade sails.

- Student numbers
 - So far 170 year 7, out of area, students have been accepted for 2019
 - 350 year 7s confirmed for 2019, likely to get up to 400.
 - At census Carine has 1555 students to date. Expected around 1700 for 2019 and 1850 for 2020 when the new buildings open.
 - The new high school being built in Subiaco, due for completion in 2020, is not expected to have an impact on Carine SHS students numbers
- Carine SHS Annual Report was presented at the meeting.
- Carine SHS Business plan was presented at the meeting

General Business

• Canteen Strategic Plan 2019

The P&C executive committee met to discuss the current state of the canteen and the past few years financial status. The canteen has been operating at a loss the last 2 years which has been accommodated by the reserve canteen funds. This situation cannot continue and needs to be addressed by the P&C. An overview document of the canteen was distributed to P&C Members and spoken to at the meeting. Two motions were presented at the meeting.

Motion 1: That a 2019 Strategic Plan for the Carine SHS canteen is formulated for the ratification at the second P&C meeting of Term 3, 2018.

Motion 2: That at the second Carine SHS P&C meeting of Term 3, 2018 the P&C make a decision as to whether the P&C continue to run the canteen after December 12, 2018.

Some comments to note from the meeting are that there will be a canteen at Carine SHS and if the P&C don't run it, it will be outsourced. The strategic plan is to be presented at the next P&C meeting for ratification. Tracey Formilan resigned from the canteen committee at the beginning of the year, 2018. At the end of 2018 current canteen committee members, Jo De Boni and Janine Vibert will resign from the canteen committee.
