



ERIDEABLE POLICY

Current as of February 2026

1. POLICY STATEMENT

Carine Senior High School does not permit students under the age of 16 to store eRideables on school grounds. No person is permitted to ride a bicycle or eRideable on school grounds at any time. Students who are over 16 and choosing to store an eRideable on school grounds must adhere to the below conditions.

2. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this policy, eRideables include, but are not limited to, eBikes, eScooters and eSkateboards.

3. POLICY SCOPE

Under current Western Australian law, all eRideable riders must be at least 16 years of age, must wear a helmet, must carry only one rider, and must comply with speed limits and road rules. The following conditions apply:

1. Only students over the age of 16 can store eRideables on school premises, and only in the designated storage area.
2. All eRideables are to be stored in the racks provided between the pool changerooms and L Block (see map below). Students travelling to school on eRideables must enter the school grounds via the gate on Osmaston Street only.
3. Students are not permitted to charge or ride eRideables anywhere else on school grounds or store eRideables other than the designated location, including against the gates around the perimeter of the school.





4. PROCEDURES

1. A student who breaches the policy will have their eRideable or eBike confiscated. This will be documented on Compass with the parent/caregiver notified. The device can only be collected by a parent or caregiver as per our records.
2. A second breach of the policy will result in a loss of Good Standing.
3. A third breach of the policy will result in a suspension, including possible further sanctions and consequences as per our Behaviour Expectations Policy.
4. A student using an eRideable or eBike contrary to the above conditions who injures a member of the school community will be immediately suspended and possible further sanctions and consequences as per our Behaviour Expectations Policy.
